

Appearance

Make sure your portfolio is clean and easy to read. Keep your colors, fonts, and pictures professional. Make it clear on the home page that this is a portfolio and put your name on it.

Organization

Make sure your portfolio follows the same organizational pattern as the example portfolio and list of requirements show. It should be organized as follows:
